Cathie was introduced to shuffleboard at Sanlan Ranch in the early 2000's. In 2003, after playing as a Sanlan interpark player five times a week, she played in her first Central District tournament in Sanlan with Dennis. They came in first, and that win was the start of her love for tournament play.

I met Cathie at Blackstock, Ontario in the summer of 2002 at the Scugog Shuffleboard Club. That was the beginning of a great friendship and shuffleboard partnership.

Cathie earned enough points to play in the 2003, 2004 and 2005 Reiny Schleier tournaments as an Amateur and came in first in all three. In 2006 and 2007 she played as a State Amateur and placed first and second. Cathie placed in the top four in the 2008, 2009, 2011, 2012 and 2013 Central District Pro Masters Tournaments.

In 2006, while still an amateur, Cathie was invited to play in the Battle of the Big Dogs Tournament in Winter Haven and came in first in the Ladies' Division.

In 2010 Cathie and I played in the first Brighthouse Tournament in St. Petersburg and came in first, winning a 50" TV for our park, Citrus Woods.

Cathie is a member of the Lakeland Shuffleboard Club and volunteers for the Polk Senior Games held at the Lakeland courts.
