Wendy played in her first Reiny the 2001-2002 season and took first place. She won first place again the next year as a State Am. Wendy turned pro in 2003 and has qualified for every Central Pro Masters since.

Wendy won both Florida State Singles tournaments she has entered, the Non-walking the first year she turned pro and the Walking division this year.

Wendy loves shuffleboard, never met a partner she didn't like, and thoroughly enjoys playing, win or lose.
