March 7, 2026

1. Meeting called to order at 9:33 A.M. by President Monroe
2. Roll call. A quorum was present.
3. Vote to Accept Agenda

7. Report Club Presidents
 - a. Betmar: President Fuller reported some improvements to the facility including new cue holders and the erection of a wall on the north side of the building to help prevent glare on the courts. They as hoping to replace courts 19-24 in the near future.
 - b. Lakeland: President Myklejord reported that preparations for the Reiny and Masters tournaments are well under way. Arrangements have been made for feeding the players for two days. Also reminded us of the Nationals to be played in Lakeland on April 27-28, 2026.

 - d. Sebring: President Martin reports the \$8000 has been spent this season on general maintenance and repairs to the facility. They now have 36 refreshed and playable courts. Also new bumpers have been installed at each court.
 - e. Winter Haven: President Nemcosky has had no further communication from the city as to the future of the courts. The 6 upper courts are to be resurfaced in the near future.
 - f. Zephyrhills: Representative Schneider reports that all courts there are in the process of being repainted and relined.

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Lakeland Shuffleboard Club for a two year trial period.” The motion was voted on and passed.

- b. 10 Day Notices
 - i) All notices were reviewed and voted on by the board. Our votes will be cast at the State meeting on March 14, 2026 by our representatives Phil Martin and Gloria Tipsword.
 - c. c). HOF Games Entry Fees
 - i) After discussion, it was decided that the money that should go to the district from the entry fees will be contributed to the prize money.
 - d. Registration Forms
 - i) The board approved the purchase of 2000 registration forms.
 - ii) Two thirds of the forms to be white, one-third of the forms to be yellow.
 - e. Masters Pins
 - i) Linda Armstrong needed clarification of the awarding of the Masters & Top 8 pins.
 - ii) As voted on in Nov. 2025, the players who play in the Masters and are not part of the top 8 will receive a participation pin. Only those who finished in the top 8 will receive a top 8 pin.
